Notes:

- The Approved Reynolds Elective and ITE 152 should be completed prior to spring of senior year.
- Students who pass the college's computer competency test will not have to enroll in ITE 115.
- The above curriculum is subject to change as circumstances warrant.
- Economics and Personal Finance is required for HS graduation. Students are encouraged to take this course prior to the end of the 10th Grade year.
- A qualifying score in an AP Social Sciences course can be used to satisfy the approved Reynolds elective.
- Beginning with the Class of 2024, the Social Science AS curriculum will be updated so that the Senior year requirement "Approved Reynolds Elective (Spring)" will change to "Approved Reynolds Humanities/Fine Arts Elective (Spring) - cannot be a literature course."
- In FA23 (not FA22) the 201-202 world languages will change from the current 4 credits to 3 credits. We will make appropriate modifications to accommodate the change will still satisfy the world language requirement in Social Science AS AFTER the curricular change takes effect.
