- Courses in green-shaded cells are required and taken at the ACA high school location (all on either A-days or B-days).
- Courses in pink-shaded cells are suggested and taken at the student's zoned school (on the other school day).
- Courses in the blue-shaded cell (ITE 152 and Approved Reynolds Elective) should be completed prior to spring of senior year.
- Students who successfully take Econ & Personal Finance in the summer or online will have a second High School elective (or study block) in 11th Grade.
- Students who successfully test out of ITE 152 and take the Reynolds elective online will have a third High School elective (or study block) in 12th Grade.
- Curriculum is subject to change as circumstances warrant.
- Beginning with the Class of 2024, the Social Science AS curriculum will be updated so that the Senior year requirement "Approved Reynolds Elective (Spring)" will change to "Approved Reynolds Humanities/Fine Arts Elective (Spring) - cannot be a literature course"
- In FA23 (not FA22) the 201-202 world languages will change from the current 4 credits to 3 credits. We will make appropriate modifications to accommodate the change in credits so that ACA students will still satisfy the world language requirement in Social Science AS AFTER the curricular change takes effect.
